5 Fire Safety Tips to Keep Your Family Safe:

- 1 Test smoke alarms monthly and know the sound of the smoke alarm if it goes off.
- 2 Change the batteries in your smoke alarm twice a year at daylight savings.
- 3 Beware of chirping smoke alarms. Chirping means the batteries need to be replaced.
- 4 How old is your smoke alarm? Replace your smoke alarm 10 years from the date of manufacture.
- 5 Sign up and create a Smart911 Safety Profile at www.smart911.com. If your home needs to be evacuated, first responders can use your Smart911 Safety Profile to know the number of residents and pets in your home and where bedrooms and access points are located.
